



## NEWS RELEASE

**September 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020, Vancouver, British Columbia, Tajiri Resources Corp. (TSXV: TAJ)** (the “**Corporation**”) is providing an update on the status of its annual audited financial statements, accompanying management discussion & analysis and related officer certifications (collectively “Annual Filings”) for the fiscal year ended April 30, 2020.

On May 19, 2020, the Canadian Securities Administrators announced that they will provide issuers with a 45-day filing extension for filings required after June 1, 2020 and prior to September 1, 2020 as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. As such, the British Columbia Securities Commission has enacted BC Instrument 51-517 (“BCI 51-517”), *Temporary Exemption from Certain Corporate Finance Requirements with Deadlines during the Period from June 2 to August 31, 2020*.

The Corporation will be relying on the temporary exemption pursuant to section 11 of BCI 51-517 in respect to the requirement to file its Annual Filings as required under NI 51-102 and NI 52-109.

The Corporation expects to file its Annual Filings on October 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

Management and insiders of the Corporation will be subject to a trading black-out policy that reflects the principles in section 9 of National Policy 11-207 *Failure-to-File Cease Trade Orders and Revocations in Multiple Jurisdictions*.

The Corporation confirms that there have been no material developments, other than those disclosed through news releases, since the filing of its interim financial statements for the period ended January 31, 2020.
